#### Celebrating 60 years another successful AGM story continued...


We also had several giveaways for our in-person and Zoom attendees! Congratulations to all of our winners! We hope you enjoy your prizes!

## KINDRED CREDIT UNION: A HISTORY OF MAKING PEACE WITH YOUR MONEY FOR 60 YEARS

On March 21, 1964, twenty-two Waterloo County Mennonites got together and deposited \$22 in a cash box and our credit union was born!

Our founders' radical vision was to see mutual aid put into faithful practice – individuals or groups bearing one another's burdens, helping each other out in times of need and in times of plenty. As a financial cooperative, it's our shared purpose and values as well as our heritage that make us who we are.

These beginnings continue to shape what we do and how we go about doing that together – through mutual aid, economic justice, and selfless service in our day-to-day financial lives.

A lot has changed since we launched on March 21, 1964, yet who we are has remained steadfast and woven into the fabric of our credit union. With variations of how we've expressed ourselves throughout the years, we have adapted and we continue to adapt, with our foundation remaining strong.

As part of our 60th Anniversary celebrations, we're exploring and sharing stories from our past. Reflecting on our history, we will see how it continues to uniquely shape how we operate today as we live out our commitment to mutual aid through the products we offer, the services we provide, and the partners we engage with.

We've begun this by sharing a three-part blog series on Kindred's history: part one explores what the original twenty-two Mennonites envisioned. In part two, we look at a name change and what those decades of growth brought to the credit union. ## KINDRED'S JOINT MORTGAGE HAS A NAME - THE HOMESHARE MORTGAGE!

Kindred's joint mortgage product is now named the HomeShare Mortgage. Although we have offered joint mortgages for some time, the product lacked a name to clearly communicate the offering.

For many Ontarians, owning a home remains a key part of "the Canadian dream" and yet rising real estate prices are a major barrier to entering the housing market. A joint mortgage can provide a viable alternative when a home is owned jointly by two or more parties.

The HomeShare Mortgage can increase market accessibility for friends or family members who combine their resources and buy a property to share.

Get access to your money immediately with Void cheque forms for direct deposits or pre-authorized payments!

You can set up direct deposits or pre-authorized payments by downloading our Void Cheque form and sending it to your depositors/bill payees. You can also use this form to change your pay deposits with your employer. This form can be downloaded after you log in to online banking and auto-includes your account information.

We've made sending and receiving money even easier with scheduled or recurring *Interac* e-Transfers for your personal or small business accounts.

Interac e-Transfer offers a convenient, contact-free way for you to send money through online banking and our mobile app, quickly and securely, to anyone with an online banking account in Canada and an email address or mobile phone.

#### ACHIEVING MUTUAL WELLBEING

As Kindred members, we continue to be encouraged to act on our founders' radical vision to put mutual aid into faithful practice – supporting each other in community to achieve mutual wellbeing. For some in our communities, simply having access to a no-fee chequing account plan can improve their financial health.

Our Generations Plan, with no monthly fee and up to 25 free transactions each month, can make a difference. Having previously been available for youth, students, and seniors, this plan is now also available for RDSP beneficiaries and individuals who qualify for, or currently receive, income support payments (including ODSP and Ontario Works).

Individuals experiencing temporary financial distress who aren't receiving income support can meet with us to discuss their eligibility for the Generations Plan.

## CHANGEMAKERS OF TOMORROW - PEACE INNOVATORS SHOWCASE

The Peace Innovators Scholarship & Mentoring Program equips young leaders with skills to tackle a problem they're passionate about in their community. These Innovators network with other leaders in high schools across Ontario, and by the end of one year, they launch an event or campaign to address their cause.

On April 27, 2024, thirteen students presented their visions of the future and how they would create change in their local communities. The seventh cohort of high school students for the 2023-2024 Peace Innovators presented on a variety of causes.
